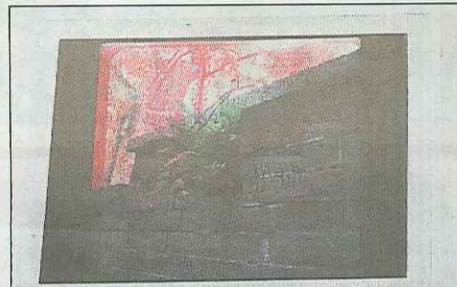

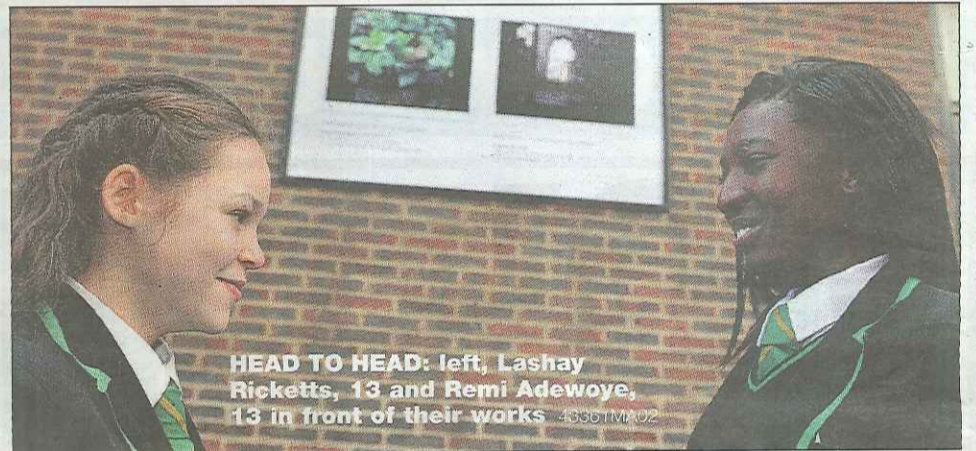

CHILDREN who studied one of the toughest poems in literature have had their work displayed in Central Brixton.

The Year 8 pupils at Evelyn Grace Academy, in Shakespeare Road, Brixton, produced stunning photographs and composed their own poems inspired by TS Elliot's *The Waste Land*.

As part of the project, they visited Tate Modern, Bankside to follow a special trail through the grounds where they used old cameras to take shots of the environment.

They have been able to apply the knowledge from studying *The Waste Land* to other work they are now doing."
